Information Package for Parents of Recreation Skaters

Winter Session: October 11, 2017-March 25, 2018

Welcome to the winter skating session at Preston Figure Skating Club (PFSC). The winter session starts on Wednesday October 11, 2017. We are looking forward to working with your child! This information package contains important information about the winter program. Please read this document carefully to ensure that you have an understanding of the program expectations as well as the various activities that take place throughout the winter session.

Required Attire and Parental Responsibilities

- All skaters must wear a CSA approved helmet for all skating sessions (helmets are only optional at the advanced recreation level). Bicycle helmets are NOT permitted.
- All skaters must wear mittens during skating sessions.
- For insurance purposes parents are not allowed on the ice for any reason. A head coach with intensive training and experience is on duty at all times to assist your child as needed. If the head coach requires your assistance they will bring your child to the ice entrance to consult with you.
- If your child needs to use the washroom a helper will bring them to the ice entrance and ask you to assist your child while they are off the ice.

End of Year Gala

At the end of the winter session your child will have an opportunity to participate in the annual skating gala for PFSC! The gala showcases all skaters, from beginner right up to international competitors. The show has many professional features including lighting, props, sets, costumes, and special effects. The gala is a great opportunity for children to show their families what they have learned during the year, and for children to learn how to perform in a fun and supportive environment. All skaters are encouraged to participate in this exciting show! The gala will be held the weekend of March 24, 2018 – please plan to join in the fun!
